Why Establish a 4-H Endowment ?

Endowments are established with belief that an excellent 4-H program will require sustained and substantial funding. All endowed gifts given to the Duval County 4-H Foundation are invested in an Endowment fund that is managed by Merrill Lynch and the Duval County 4-H Endowment Trustees.

The gifts are invested into perpetuity and the distribution of the income from these invested contributions is used to support the purposes of the Duval County 4-H Program.

Endowments are a permanent source of funds for scholarships and other vital parts of the Duval County 4-H program. They have made a significant impact on the youth of Duval County in years past and will do so in the future.



How to Establish an Endowment!

With a minimum donation of \$5,000, you can establish a named Endowment within the fund. This endowment can bear your and/or spouse's name, or any other person, organization or business you'd like to recognize.

Or you can create an endowment using an

Installment Plan

Using the **Installment Plan** you can start building an endowment with a pledge to donate a minimum of \$1,000 annually for over a period of 5 years. When the donations reach \$5,000 it will be recognized at the Green Clover level and you will be able to name the endowment. The Endowment would then be recognized in the month and year it reaches \$5,000. You can continually add to your endowment, when it reaches the next level, it will be recognized at that higher level.
